




Band 8. Die Besatzungszeit und die Entstehung zweier Staaten 1945-1961 Abbildungen von Innenraumeinrichtungen



Question: "Supposing you wanted to refurnish a room and needed to buy a side-board and an armchair. Here is a small selection of each: which would you choose?" (IS)






